## Classic City Majorettes - Information Sheet 2023-2024

Welcome to Baton Twirling! We are looking forward to an exciting year and can't wait to teach your child all about twirling! Please help your child remember to practice at home in order to get the most out of the class. Most of all they should HAVE FUN! Listed below is some information you need to know about the upcoming year. Please review the following information before signing your child up for class.

What to wear to Baton Class: Student's must wear appropriate clothing to all practices. Appropriate clothing includes shorts, t-shirts, tennis shoes and socks. Sandals, skirts, dresses, jeans, etc., are not acceptable due to the increased risk of injury.

**Food and drinks** will not be permitted during class time. All snacks should be finished before class begins. The only exception – you may bring water or a sports-type drink to have during our break time.

## Baton/Uniforms/Recital Fees - total due: \$290

- Baton: A baton is required for this class. I will take measurements at open house and the batons will be in by the following week.
- Recital/Performance Fee: This helps pay for props used in our routines, recital expenses including trophies and other supplies needed to ensure a quality twirling program.
- Uniforms: Uniforms for the year include a t-shirt and shorts, a sequin tank top, a jacket and leggings and a costume worn at competitions and recital. Uniforms are required for performances.

**All fees are due as follows:** Fall Session: August 29; Spring Session: March 5 If you sign up for both sessions, you only pay the fee one time.

If you are a returning student, let me know which pieces you have outgrown and I will order those separately.

I will take measurements and sizes at Open House or at your child's first class. The following items will be ordered for performances:

- **1. T-shirts and shorts**: A "Classic City Majorettes" t-shirt and red shorts will be worn for the early fall performances, summer parades and other performances. You can also wear these items to practice.
- 2. Sequin tank top: A red sequin tank top will be worn at the basketball game performances and in the Christmas Parades under our jackets.
- **3. Jacket and Leggings:** A "Classic City Majorettes" jacket and leggings is worn for the Christmas parades and other outdoor performances as needed. This is a nice quality red, black and white jacket with our name embroidered on the pocket area, and nice, thick leggings.
- **4. Dance-Twirl Costume**: This uniform is worn to indoor performances. This will be something "sparkly" that will go along with the theme and song selected for your child's class.
- **5. Hair Accessory**: The uniform fee also includes hair accessories to match the uniforms. These will be distributed in time for the first performance.

Checks should be made payable to "Melanie Baer". I also accept cash, credit cards, Venmo, Paypal and CashApp as payment options. Batons and uniforms will not be ordered until paid for. The deadline to order for Fall Session is August 29<sup>th</sup> and for Spring Session is March 5<sup>th</sup>. If you sign up for both sessions, you only pay this fee once.

In addition to the items listed above, you will need a pair of white keds or white twirling shoes to wear with the shorts and t-shirts and in parades, and a pair of tan or hazelnut jazz shoes and matching tights to wear with the dance-twirl uniform. These items are not included in the uniform fee and will be needed later on this fall.

\*\*All uniforms and shoes are required for performances. We participate in many performances in the community and we want to look our best!
